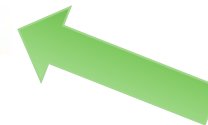

Provincial Graduation Assessments

- ❑ Written at school, offered certain times per year
- ❑ To graduate students will write:
 - ❑ Literacy Assessment – grade 10
 - ❑ Numeracy Assessment – grade 10
 - ❑ Literacy Assessment – grade 12
 - ❑ French Literacy Assessment for French Immersion 12 students – in addition to the 3 above
- ❑ Students who wish to rewrite or missed it in grade 10 need to speak with their counsellor



Provincial Graduation Assessments



Assessments will be:

- Marked on 4 point proficiency scale
 - Emerging / Developing / Proficient / Extending
- Reported separately on transcript

Gr. 10 Assessments will NOT be:

- Blended with any school course mark
- Used by the Post Secondary schools at this point
- Used as a pass/ fail



Post Secondary Program Requirements

- Typical Science or Engineering Programs require 2 Grade 12 Sciences PLUS Physics 11
- Typical Humanities / Arts Programs require 4-5 Grade 12 Academic course (may include Sciences)
- Typical Commerce program requires Pre-Calculus 12 (Calculus 12 recommended)
- Each PSI sets their own requirements and these may change without notice!

- **ENGLISH 12**

- UBC & SFU – min. 70%
- UVIC – min. 67%
- CAP U – min. 67%

- **SECOND LANGUAGE 11**

- UBC – Completion of Language 11 to meet general admissions;
 - Bachelor of Arts – need either Language 12 OR
1st or 2nd year Language course during degree
- SFU – Completion of Intro Language 11
- No Second Language Requirement for MOST other university in Canada.
