

## **Windsor Library & Learning Commons**

The Windsor Library & Learning Commons welcomes all students!

The Windsor Library & Learning Commons is open for tutorial from 8:30-9:10 and from 9:10 - 3:30 pm, Monday to Friday for library instruction, book loans, and student access to computers and the library printer.

The Windsor Library boasts a high-quality collection of English and French print resources including Fiction, Non-Fiction, as well as several special collections such as Indigenous Resources, Narrative Non-Fiction, 'Personal Improvement', Fast Reads, Manga, Picture Fiction and more. A full view of the Windsor Library collection of resources is available through [Destiny Discover](#). Students can log into this system to search for titles and place items on hold. Hold items will be kept at the front circulation desk for one week.

Print resources are available for a three-week loan period; Kindle e-readers, lapel microphones and a green screen are also available for two-week loans. If loaned library materials are needed for a longer period, an extension can be granted. To ensure maximum availability of library resources, their prompt return guarantees that everyone can enjoy the various library resources at the school. All school textbooks are now signed out to students through the library system to keep better track of resources and to minimize losses. \*Please note that that if library or textbook loans are not returned, lost, or damaged, a replacement cost will be charged and added to a student's School Cash Online account.

The library also has games, puzzles, colouring books, chess sets and a bee hive!
