Dear Parents/Guardians of Grades 10-12 students,

The BC Graduation Program requires all students to sit Graduation Assessments as part of their graduation requirements. This year, the Windsor Ministry Graduation Assessment Schedule is as follows:

- Grade 12 Graduation Literacy Assessment November 4, 2024
- Grade 10 Graduation Literacy Assessment January 22nd & 23, 2025
- Grade 10 Graduation Numeracy Assessment April 9th & 10, 2025
- Grade 12 Évaluation de littératie de la 12^e année Français langue seconde immersion (For French Immersion students only) June 10th & 11, 2025

The purpose of these assessments is to measure the extent to which students are literate and numerate and to provide students with information about their proficiency. Rather than assess specific course curricula, the provincial graduation assessments measure the application of numeracy and literacy skills in realistic situations by requiring students to apply their knowledge and skills to analyze, reason, and communicate effectively as they examine, interpret, and solve problems. Graduation assessments also emphasize the importance of the context in which students should be able to use their skills (e.g., home, employment, society) (BC Ministry of Education).

Students are expected to take the Grade 10 Graduation Assessments in their grade 10 year and the Grade 12 Graduation Assessment(s) in their grade 12 year. Assessment dates are set by the Ministry and are non-negotiable. Students who miss a session will be automatically enrolled in the next one.

Below is the detailed schedule for the upcoming Literacy 12 Assessment. Students should report to their assigned assessment location 15 minutes prior to the start time. Detailed schedules for the future assessments will be sent home to families closer to the assessment date.

IMPORTANCE NOTICE: All Grade 12 Classes are cancelled November 4th to facilitate students' writing of the Assessment.

Students have 2 hours to write the assessment plus one additional hour if needed. Assessments are scored on a proficiency scale. The student's best outcome for each of the Provincial Graduation Assessments will be recorded on their BC Ministry of Education Transcript. Students can access Assessment Scores via the BC Transcript Service or MyEd BC (Please note: All students should have set up their own BC Transcript Service Account in their Grade 10 year). Students may request to re-write an assessment by informing the Vice-Principal.
