

Are you a Hidden Apprentice?

If you are a student working part time in a trade, you could be a hidden apprentice.

What is Youth Work in Trades?

The Youth Work in Trades program provides graduation credits for hours worked toward an apprenticeship under the supervision of a certified tradesperson. The program is designed for students who are currently working part time in a trade under a certified trade person or who know of someone who might hire them to work in a trade.

Who is eligible?

Students in grades 10 to 12 at all North Vancouver School District schools.

Benefits

- Earn a paycheque while still in school
- Earn up to 16 elective credits towards graduation
- Acquire in-demand skills
- May be eligible for \$1,000 Youth Work in Trades Award

\$1,000 Youth Work in Trades Award

No application is required; students are automatically considered upon completion of the following:

- Register with SkilledTradesBC as a Youth Apprentice
- Graduate with a Grade 12 Dogwood or Adult Dogwood diploma
- Complete WRK 11A, WRK 11B, WRK 12A, and WRK 12B
- Maintain a C+ average or better on grade 12 courses
- Report a total of at least 900 hours to SkilledTradesBC by January 31 of the school year the student turns 19
