# NVSD Re-opening Plan



## Grade 8 to 12 Model – 20% School Density Target

- Maintain online learning experiences
- Focus in-class instruction on Priority Learners
- Teachers and/or students arrange times for extra support
- Health and safety protocols in place
  - Maximum attendance of 20% of total population

## Priority Learners

- Children of Essential Service Workers
- Any student who requires additional support  
This may include:
  - Students with complex medical and/or developmental needs
  - Students with social, emotional and mental health related needs
  - Students who are at risk of not passing a course / graduating
  - Students who are struggling in a remote learning environment
  - Students who are and are not formally identified

# NVSD Re-opening Plan



## Final Week June 22 - 26

Students return to school for brief visit

- Individual times allocated
- Structured timetable
- Maximum 20% occupancy
- Return/collect materials
- Closure to the school year



## Elementary Survey Results

Total responses 7,564 (78.2 % of total elementary enrollment)

Yes	3,744	(49.5% of responses received)
Maybe	1,994	(26.4% of responses received)
No	1,826	(24.1% of responses received)

# “Why” Messages:

- NVSD efforts to reduce COVID-19 make our schools safe for students and staff

  - Current science indicates children are low risk to transmit the virus
- Schools are critical to student learning and important community hubs. Time away from school deepens inequity.
