Provincial Online Learning School (POLS) 63 courses from Grade 8-12 in English or French


"Classroom Alternative"



#### 2022-2023 School Goals:


- #1: Implement equity-based practices to support the inclusion and sense of belonging of all students.

# Innovative Instruction & Assessment








- Continuous entry school
  - Students can enroll at any time from September to June
- Asynchronous instructional model
  - · Students begin the courses when they are ready
  - Student have one calendar year to complete from enrollment date
- Flexibility for learners
  - Learners set their own goals for completion timeline
  - Slow the pace to develop deep understanding & honing of skills
  - · Accelerate their learning to advance quickly through the course

- NVOL awarded a \$350,000 one-time grant of federal funds
- Targeted funding to develop French Immersion courses
- NVOL hired two full time French Immersion teachers

  - Études du cinéma et de la littérature francophones 11
  - Langue et culture de la francophonie 11
