Your design will be entirely composed of the following **six types of algebra tiles**:

- small square = 1
- small square (alternate colour) = -1
- rectangle =  $x$
- rectangle (alternate colour) =  $-x$
- big square =  $x^2$
- big square (alternate colour) =  $-x^2$
