The restored language will dramatically improve class size and compensation but we all have a lot of work to do to ensure successful implimentation. Further, there are still many other areas that will demand our funding support.



1. Ensure the government truly funds our restored language as it pertains to North Vancouver



NVTA Budget priorities What does this mean?



This means that the space is there for the 100 new classrooms we will need in the fall.



The agreement reached between the BCTF and the government and ratified by 98% of teachers makes clear that every district must make every effort possible to ensure that the class size and composition language is followed.



This means looking at schools that have been closed, ordering all the necessary portables, reviewing the plans for Argyle to ensure it meets the new numbers.



The NVTA is confident that the trustees will advocate for ensuring we have the necessary space for all our wonderful new classrooms with the incredibly supportive learning environments that our restored language will create.



NVTA Budget priorities But let's not rob Peter to pay Paul.



2. Ensure services currently supported by the Ed Fund are maintained and enhanced.



A minimum of 2 FTE for the Hearing Resource team.

2017-2018 Caseload numbers are projected based on students that are graduating or changes that we are aware of as of March2017. These numbers do not take into account new students in the fall.



NVTA Budget priorities A minimum of 8.3 FTE for school psychologists



A minimum 7.4 FTE for Speech and Language Pathologists, which would restore service to the levels prior to 2010.



3. Other areas:

School Cleanliness

 Custodial time to clean each classroom each day

Defibrillators

The New Curriculum

- Access to Curriculum Training for Part Time Teachers and TTOCs
