To work in partnership with mainstream schools to provide students with **flexible**, **innovative**, and **personalized** pathways to graduation through interactive and engaging online learning experiences.




School Plan Goals

- ▶ #1: Implement equity-based practices to support the inclusion and sense of belonging of all students.
- ▶ #2: Create more flexibility and increase student agency and autonomy in NVOL courses.



- Provincial Online Learning School (POLs)
- "Classroom Alternative"
- 65 courses from Grade 8-12
- Aligned with the B.C. curriculum
- Designed & taught by certified teachers
- All instruction and resources delivered through Brightspace LMS





North Vancouver Online Learning



- 1450 students enrolled in secondary level courses
- Students from 119 different schools across the province
- 32% of our student population from outside NVSD
- Every NVSD Family of Schools community enrolls in NVOL

Learning anywhere, anytime, on any device

- Continuous entry school
 - Enroll any time from September to June
- Asynchronous instructional model
 - Students begin courses when they are ready
- Students have one calendar year to complete from date of enrollment
 - Access to courses over the summer
