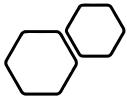

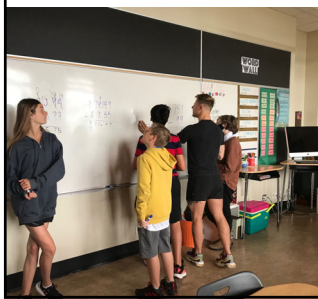
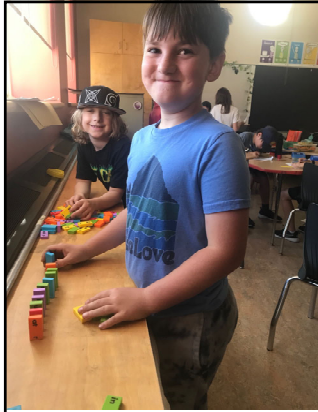

Elementary Summer Learning at Queen Mary

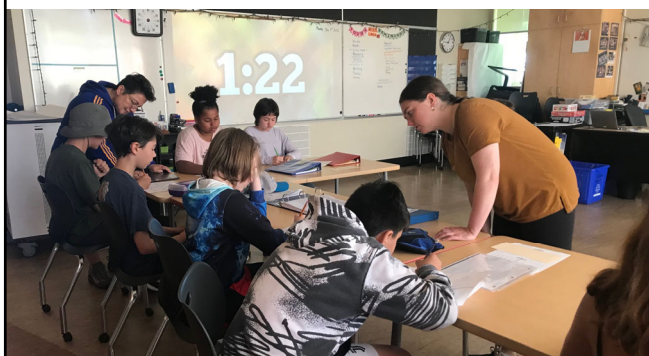

- Designed specifically for each unique individual's strengths & stretches

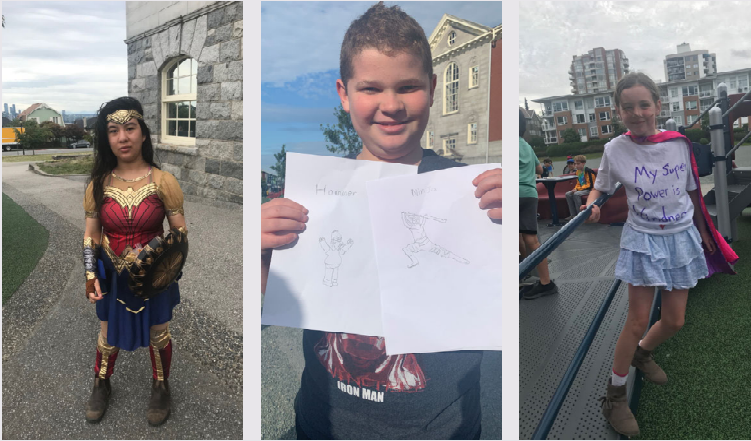


Elementary Summer Learning at Queen Mary

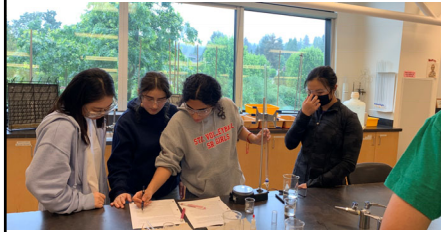

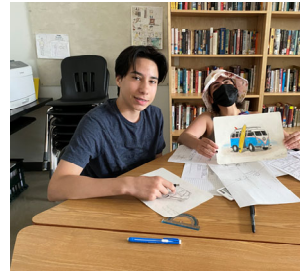
