## Elementary Classes

Kindergarten: including $\mathrm{K} / 1$ combined classes
Primary: Grades 1 to 3, including 3/4 combined classes
Intermediate: Grades 4 to 7

Class size maximums remain for Kindergarten and K/Gr. 1 combined classes (22),
Primary and Gr. 3/4 combined classes (24). District averages are no longer in effect.
These were (Kindergarten; < 19, Primary Grade 1 to 3; < 21, Grades 4 to 7; < 28,
Grades 8 to $12 ;<30$.
Averages for these grade groupings have been provided for comparative purposes.

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## Elementary Classes > 30

Two regular classes (divisions) in elementary schools exceed 30 students (Cove Cliff [31] and Lynn Valley [32]).

A total of four band (4) and strings (1) classes in four different schools exceed 30 students. Six in 2013/14

In 2013/14, there were two regular divisions exceeding 30 students and there were seven band classes in six different schools with classes exceeding 30 students.





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## Secondary Classes

- Increase in number of classes with more than 30 students, and in number of classes with 22 and fewer students compared to 2013/14
- Blocks added through the Education Fund after classes were organized - very limited, or no impact on class sizes
- Reduction in average class sizes
24.3 in 2014/15-24.5 in 13/14, 25.1 in 12/13, 26.4 in 11/12

Secondary classes < 22, 22 - Compared to prior years
