



Artists for Kids

Artists for Kids offers various programs that support focused training for elementary and secondary students with professional artists at the AFK Studios. Each year, in the **Mentoring Emerging Young** Artists programs, North Vancouver secondary students participate in three-day intensive programs, focusing on a specific topic. Fashion photography, landscape and the built environment have all been explored in previous years by students in the AFK $photography\,mentorship.$ This year students have been given the opportunity to work with portrait photographer Birthe Piontek and a variety of industry professionals. Some of the work will be published in the North Shore News on March 1 prior to the exhibition launch of their work at Artists for Kids in the Gordon Smith Gallery on March 7.
