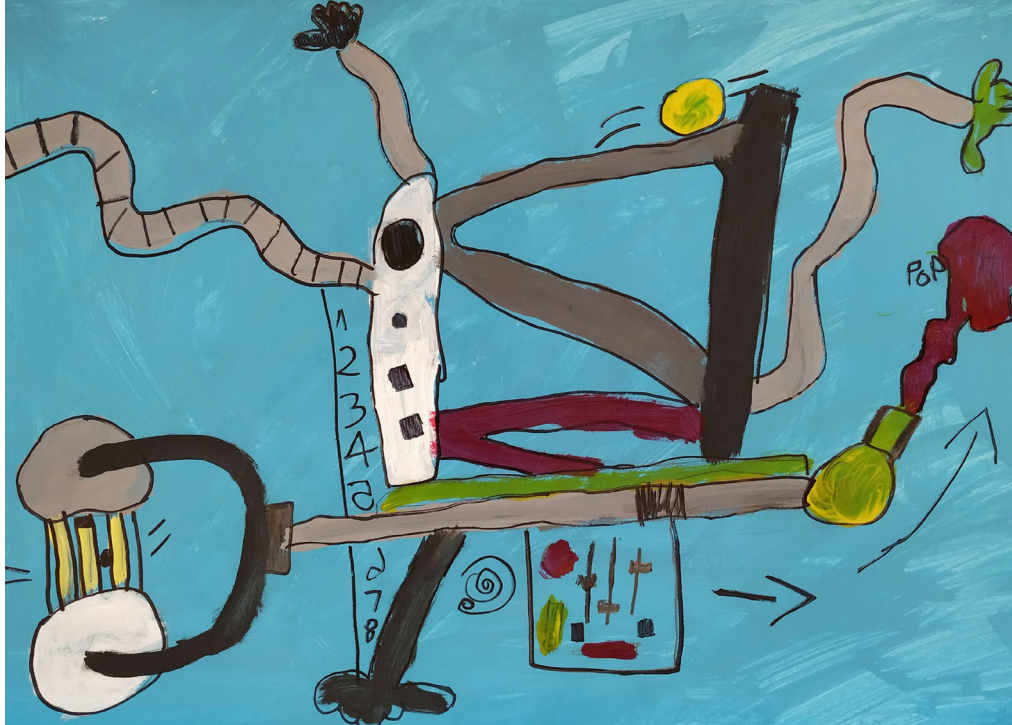




Spring 2019 AFTER SCHOOL ART PROGRAMS
