This grant can be used toward future full-time and part-time studies in vocational schools, apprenticeships, trades training, college or university.

Deadlines for other eligible groups of children are as follows:

- Children born between 2010 and 2012 have until their 9th birthday to apply.
- Children born in 2013 can start applying on their 6th birthday.
