Hello Argyle Families!

We hope you had an enjoyable Thanksgiving last weekend. This week marked the midway point of Quarter 1 and the delivery switch for Grade 9 to 12 students. As students are now entirely face to face for their afternoon class, this class is now their learning cohort. In the morning class only half the students are present at one time and they are required to maintain physical distance, and to wear a mask if they are unable to physically distance themselves for certain activities. All students are welcome to wear a mask at any time during class and are required to wear one in common areas.

The home-school partnership is critical to student success. All students will be receiving a progress update on October 28<sup>th</sup>. These will be published to the MyEd Parent Portal. # 1. Interims

a. Interims will be published once per quarter to the MyEd Parent Portal on the following dates. Parents will receive an email notification from "SysAdmin" once published.

Quarter 1 – Wednesday, October 28

Quarter 2 – Wednesday, December 16

Quarter 3 – Wednesday, March 10

Quarter 4 – Wednesday, June 2

b. Students in linear "X-block" classes will not receive an interim, however, they will receive a report card at the end of each Quarter (4 times per year).

# 2. <u>Reminder about Extra Support for ALL students</u>

There are many opportunities for students to receive additional support this year. Often a few minutes can go a long way to alleviating stress, clarifying concepts, and helping learners gain a deeper understanding of a topic. These are drop-in times and available to any student. Please encourage your child to access these opportunities.

- a. Teacher Tutorials during Flex teachers have shared tutorial times with students
- b. Drop-in Support during Flex Time in the "Learning Café" (cafeteria) supported by Educational Assistants
- c. Drop-in Support during lunch in the Learning Café supported by volunteer Senior Students

\*Students & Staff are required to wear a mask in the Learning Café as it is a common space.

### 3. School Calendar

A few notes about the calendar:

• To help balance the number of face-to-face sessions for Group A & B there are a few Mondays during the year where Group B will meet face to face instead of an online class for all students. These are on:

- Monday, November 23
- Monday, April 19
- Monday, June 21

• The first day of each Quarter starts with all grade 9 to 12's doing an online class in the afternoon. Students will be notified at that time whether they are in Group A or B.

• Report cards will be posted after the conclusion of each quarter. The dates are listed on the school calendar.

• Updates to the calendar will posted to the online calendar linked to the homepage of the school website.
