Hello Grads!

It may be hard to believe but you will soon be starting your last semester of your high school career! Well done! There are several upcoming critical deadlines and events that I want to draw your attention to.

Please make note of the following events and due dates:

1. GRAD SEMI FORMAL DINNER DANCE

Tickets are on sale on School Cash Online. The deadline to purchase a ticket is January 25th. The event is on Tuesday, January 31st at the Italian Cultural Centre from 6:30pm to 10pm. Tickets are \$85 each. This is a school sponsored event and the school code of conduct is in effect.

2. GRAD YEARBOOK WRITE UP & BABY PHOTO – Due February 1st

To acknowledge your experiences and growth we now need a grad yearbook write-up and an optional baby photo to accompany your Grad photo in the Yearbook. NOTE: THE YEARBOOK WRITE-UP IS NOT SIMPLY A QUOTE FOR THE YEARBOOK. Although you may include a quote as part of your entry, the write-up is more a reflection of the key memories of your high school experience.

Guidelines and examples of write ups are on the Teams form linked below. If we do not receive a write-up, the area beside your grad photo will be left blank.

3. YEARBOOK ORDER DEADLINE – February 1st

The last day to purchase a yearbook through School Cash Online is February 1st. We do not order extra yearbooks to sell in June. Every June we have grads who regret not ordering a yearbook; don't let this be you! Yearbooks are \$50 each.

4. ARGYLE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION DEADLINE – due 9am January 27th

The deadline to submit an Argyle scholarship & bursary application is Friday, January 27th at 9am. **Late applications are NOT accepted.** To be considered for an Argyle scholarship you must submit an application, letter, and be a student in good standing. Start this application early as there are several components to it including writing a letter. Ms. Malone has posted the application and instructions in the Argyle Scholarship Team which all grads are part of.

5. GRAD ASSESSMENTS

Grade 12's are scheduled to write their Literacy 12 graduation assessment between January 23rd to 26th. Please double check the date and time you have been assigned on the lists posted on the office windows. This assessment is required to graduate so don't miss it!

Grade 12 semester 1 Français Langue students also have their French Literacy 12 assessment. The oral component is January 17th or 18th (check the lists for your assigned date & time). The written component is January 25th at 9am. Semester 2 FRAL 12 students will complete this assessment in June.

Students must arrive 15 minutes prior to the start of their exam. If you are unable to write for any reason, please see Ms. Sigurdsson to ensure you are signed up for a rewrite date in April.

6. CLC

Grads, please make sure you are keeping up with your CLC 12 assignments! This course is REQUIRED to graduate. The course wraps up at the end of April with your Capstone project. If you are unclear about any assignment come to Flex Time to meet with your teacher, or message them on Teams.
