

SOLUTION

River Crossing

Three travellers need to cross a river. The first traveller (orange) has two bags. The second traveller (green) has one bag. The third traveller (pink) has no bags. Rules:

- 1. The raft can hold either two travellers OR one traveller and one bag
- 2. No traveller should be left alone with another traveller's bag



The orange passenger goes across with one of his bags first. He leaves his first bag on the other side and returns to the start to pick up his second bag. He delivers his second bag to the other side and returns. Now, he picks up the pink passenger and they make their way across. The pink passenger leaves the orange passenger on the other side and returns to the starting point. The pink passenger and the green passenger cross the rivre together. The pink passenger stays and the green passenger returns to finally pick up his bag and cross the river.
