Some scissors and rulers will be purchased to top up our existing classroom collection for student use but will belong to the classroom.

Following are some individual, essential items that will still need to be provided by the home:

These items should be clearly marked with the child's first and last name.

- **Large backpack** for carrying home library books, class work, projects, snacks, lunches etc.
- **Gym bag** (drawstring bag) which must contain the sometimes-necessary change of clothing in case of accidents, or wet, muddy days.
- An extra pair of **rubber-soled shoes** to be left at school for a change on muddy days and for use in the gym.
- Headphones or ear buds.

These items should be clearly marked with the child's first and last name.
