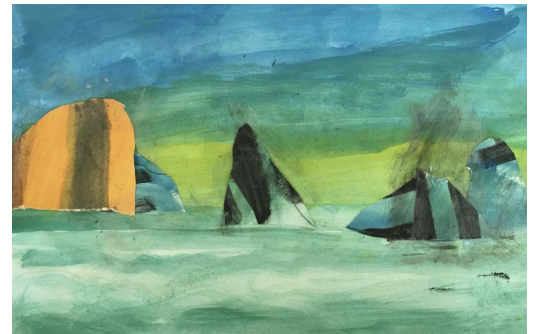

Primarily Painting
