**checked frequently.*

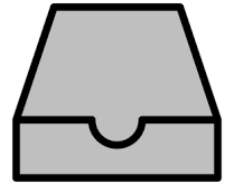
You don't have to wait until the day of the absence to report it if you know ahead of time.
