### **Careers 8 and 9**

One of the big focuses of the BC education curriculum is student career preparation. The main goal of career education curriculum is to promote successful, educated citizens who can effectively manage their life journeys toward preferred future possibilities. At Carson Graham, the career education curriculum is delivered as an integrated part of all our courses, helping students identify and develop their personal interest, passions and competencies.

As a way to enhance the great work, reflection and exploration that already occurs within the classroom in the area of career education, we are asking grade 8 and 9 students to complete a series of short personal reflection tasks on MyBlueprint. MyBlueprint is a digital portfolio program that will help guide students throughout high school in career education.

These tasks will help students explore more about themselves and help them discover different paths. These tasks will also set students up for success in grade 10 when they are enrolled in Career Life Education 10 (a graduation require course) and for their Person Project 10 course (requirement for a MYP IB Certificate). Attached are detailed instructions on how students can access their MyBlueprint account. In order to complete all the tasks our recommendation is that students complete at least one task a month. All tasks must be completed.
