

University Transfer Programs

A great option for students who :

- Do not meet all of the entrance requirements
- Want to upgrade their courses
- Would appreciate a smaller campus and smaller class sizes
- Not 100% sure what direction they want to take with their studies
- Can complete an Associate Degree in Ats or Science (60 credits)
- Can transfer up to 60 credits towards degree at University

How to apply for Admissions

- Apply online
- Need PEN, desired Faculty (1^{st &} 2nd choice)
- Pay Fee (Credit card)
- Self-Reporting use Transcript Verification
- Check status often





Once you apply...

Stay organized to stay on top of it!

- Keep track of applications
- You will receive student number & information on how to track your application status
- Check if additional/supplemental applications are needed (watch dates)
- Continue to monitor account for any additional paperwork/deadlines etc.



Accepting an Offer

- Many schools extend offers throughout the Spring in multiple rounds and well into the summer
- Different programs offer at different times, so don't worry if your friends have heard and you haven't
- You will likely need to pay a deposit when you accept the offer – you can accept offers at more than one institution (except in Ontario) but it will cost you
- All offers are conditional read conditions of each offer carefully
- All offers are confirmed in July once final grades have been released by the Ministry of Education to Institutions



Reference Letters

- Students should be prepared to provide a resume or other information to support the letter.
