



2020 - ATL - Self Assessment (Core Competencies)

As part of the Ministry of Education graduation requirements, all students must complete a self-assessment of the core competencies. At Carson Graham students self-assess the Approaches to Learning Skills: Self-Management, Communication, Thinking, Social, and Research.

To qualify for graduation, students must complete one formal Self-Assessment each year of high school.

To complete this grad requirement, students are to select 3 different artifacts (sample pieces of work) they are proud of from this school year. These 3 artifacts should demonstrate your strengths and growth over this year in the 5 ATL skills areas.

Then write one reflection for each artifact. Discuss as many ATL skills per artifact reflection that you deem appropriate. Over the three reflections, you need to discuss all 5 ATL skills. For example, you might reflect on a group project that shows your social, research and communication skills.

Students are to complete the Self-Assessment on a portfolio application called myBlueprint.

To sign into MyBlueprint

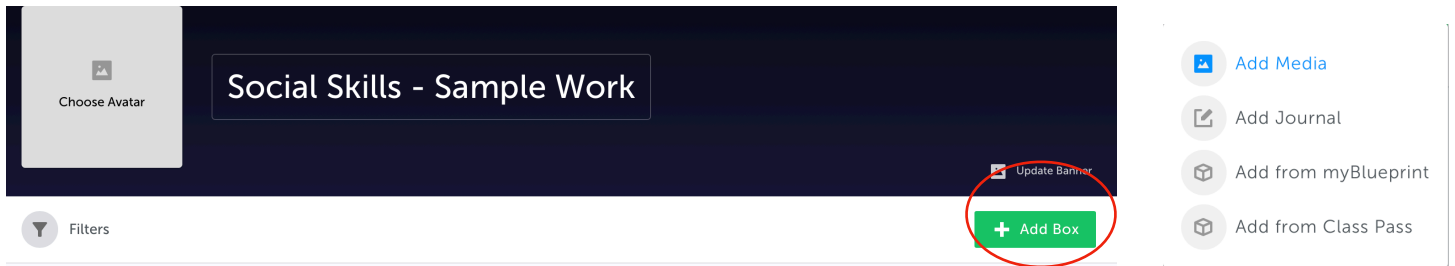

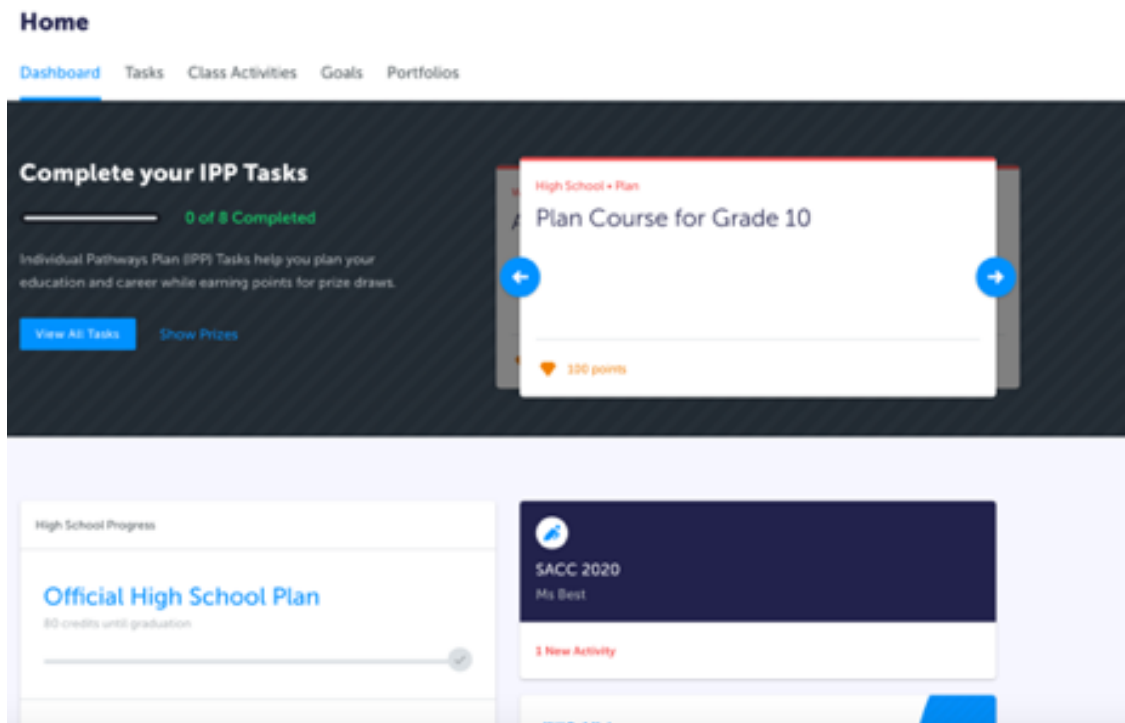

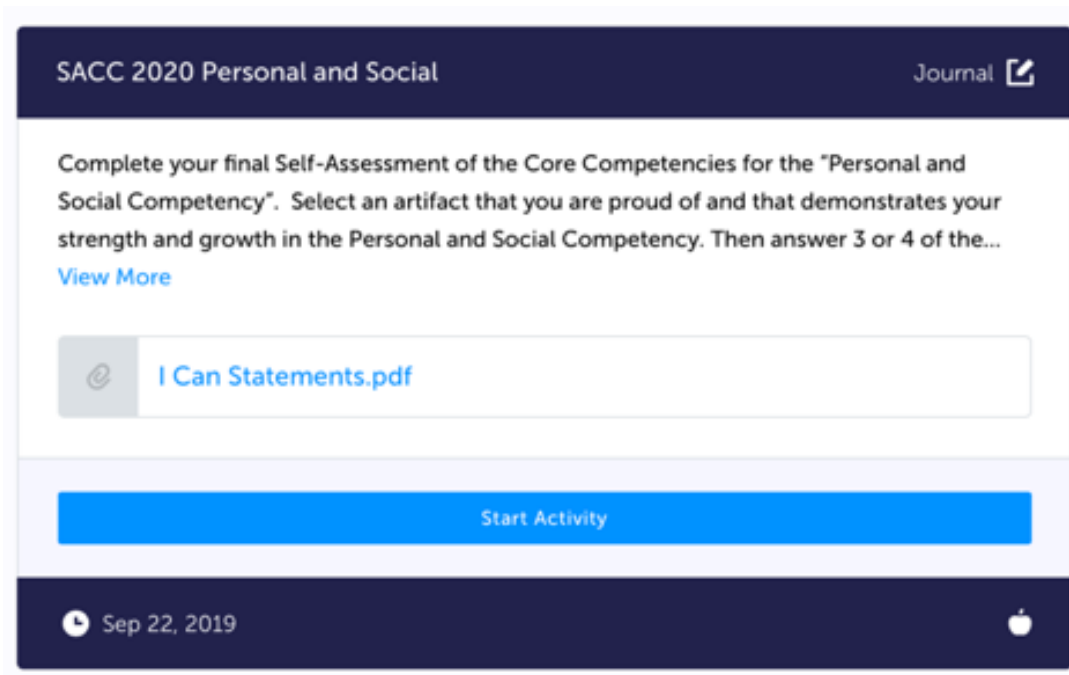


Submitting your self-assessment reflections
