- **Student Drop Off/Pick Up** - Our parking lots are **NOT** for student pick up and drop off. If you are at the front round-about, do not leave your car, as this area is for drop off and pick up only. No Parking. We have buses and emergency vehicles that need access to the round-about. Thank you for your co-operation and for keeping our community safe. When the cones are up blocking driveway access, please do not drive through or block the traffic delineators. As you may have noticed, we have new white traffic delineators. Please do not pull up beside or on them, thank you! Our back parking lot is congested with parents using the back parking lot as well. Our staff are trying to park to sponsor our events and often can't find a place to park. Please use the streets to park and drop off.

- **Please ...No Dogs on School Property** The District of North Vancouver by-law prohibits dogs from certain public spaces such as school grounds –(for exact wording of the regulation 5981, please refer to the North Vancouver District website restricting dogs from school grounds).
