Information and Reminders

- **Student Drop Off/Pick Up** - Our parking lots are **NOT** for student pick up and drop off. If you are at the front round-about, do not leave your car, as this area is for drop off and pick up only. No Parking. We have buses and emergency vehicles that need access to the round-about. Thank you for your co-operation and for keeping our community safe. When the cones are up blocking driveway access, please do not drive through or block the traffic delineators. As you may have noticed, we have new white traffic delineators. Please do not pull up beside or on them, thank you! Our back parking lot is congested with parents using the back parking lot as well. Our staff are trying to park to sponsor our events and often can't find a place to park. Please use the streets to park and drop off.
- **Please ...No Dogs on School Property** The District of North Vancouver by-law prohibits dogs from certain public spaces such as school grounds –(for exact wording of the regulation 5981, please refer to the North Vancouver District website restricting dogs from school grounds). While our four-legged friends are usually just that -friends –some children at school are allergic to dogs while others can often be frightened of them. Even when leashed or tethered to a fence, dogs can be unpredictable especially when the owner is not present. In other cases, and despite

many owners' best efforts, they can and do leave 'calling cards' on the grounds –not pleasant for anyone who may step or slide into them unintentionally... Thank you in advance for helping us maintain a safe and pleasant environment for all members of our school community
