- Vaccines are a healthy choice for your child.
- They provide immunity and prevent disease.
- Two vaccines are provided free for Kindergarten age children starting at age four:
 1. Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis (Whooping Cough), Polio (DTPPO)
 2. Chickenpox (Varicella), dose two

During your kindergarten visit your child's record will be checked for protection against the following diseases:

✓Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis (Whooping Cough), Polio

✓Hepatitis B

✓Meningococcal C

✓MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)

✓Pneumococcal

✓Varicella (Chickenpox)
