About Diana & Kris: Diana Lee and Kris Young played four years on the senior team at Handsworth Secondary School, capping off their careers with B.C. 'AAA' Provincial Championship victories in 2009 and 2010. Diana was the provincial tournament's Most Valuable Player in 2009 while Kris won the same honour in 2010. They were both awarded the Quinn Keast Foundation Scholarship in 2010 after their careers with the Royals.

Upon graduating, Kris joined the University of British Columbia Thunderbirds while Diana suited up for the Boise State University Broncos. After finishing her degree at Boise State, Diana moved back to Vancouver and started her Masters degree at UBC to be reunited with Kris on the Thunderbirds roster. Diana is in her first season at UBC. Diana and Kris both played for Canada in 2011 at the FIBA U19 World Championships for Women in Chile. The team finished fifth after winning eight of nine games, including one over the United States.

- Three-year starter at Boise State University
- All-WAC Freshmen Team and Academic All-Western Athletic Conference in 2011
- Academic All-Mountain West in all three seasons she played with Boise State
- Played for Canada at 2010 FIBA Americas U18 Championship Tournament



KRIS YOUNG



- 2012-13 Canada West Most Valuable Player, finishing as the only player in the league to finish in the top 10 in scoring, assists rebounding and steals.
- Three-time Canada West league All-Star
- Two-time Canadian Interuniversity Sport All-Canadian
- 2012 CIS National Championship tournament All-Star after leading UBC to the gold-medal game

- Holds the UBC school record for most assists in a game with 12 (Feb. 23, 2012)

- Played for Canada at the 2013 World University Games in Kazan, Russia
