Happy 2013!

It is really great to see everyone back and ready to learn. As a staff we have talked about character development and its' role in a child's level of success. It's important to all Lynnmour staff that your children are successful. Character is as important as academics in helping children become successful adults. Character isn't always about morality; it's more about learning a set of skills to help children achieve their goals. Character strengthens over time and failure is an important stepping stone on the way to success. Trying something new and reaching outside of their comfort zones will help to develop a child's character. Seven character traits that are important to being successful include: Grit, Curiosity, Self-control, Social Intelligence, Zest, Optimism, and Gratitude.

Our school wide focus for the month of February will be "Random Acts of Kindness". Kindness means showing concern about the welfare and feeling of others. When children understand that kindness can make a difference they will be more likely to incorporate that behaviour in their own lives. Each class will begin the month by reading the picture book called "Ordinary Mary does an Extraordinary Deed." Students are encouraged to think about the kind things they say or do for others and will be asked to record them on our "Random Acts of Kindness" bulletin board in the main hall.
