Learner Profile in Action

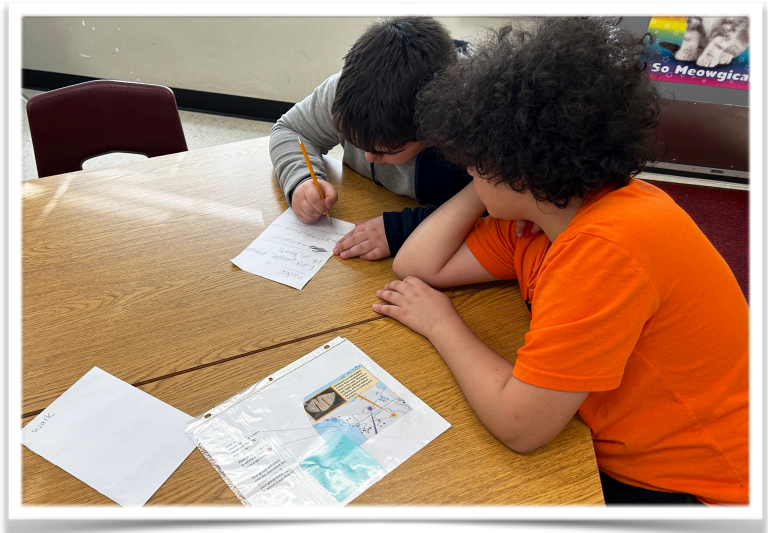


Balanced: Students at all grade levels (Grade 6/7s featured here), learned field hockey stick-handling skills - *not easy!*

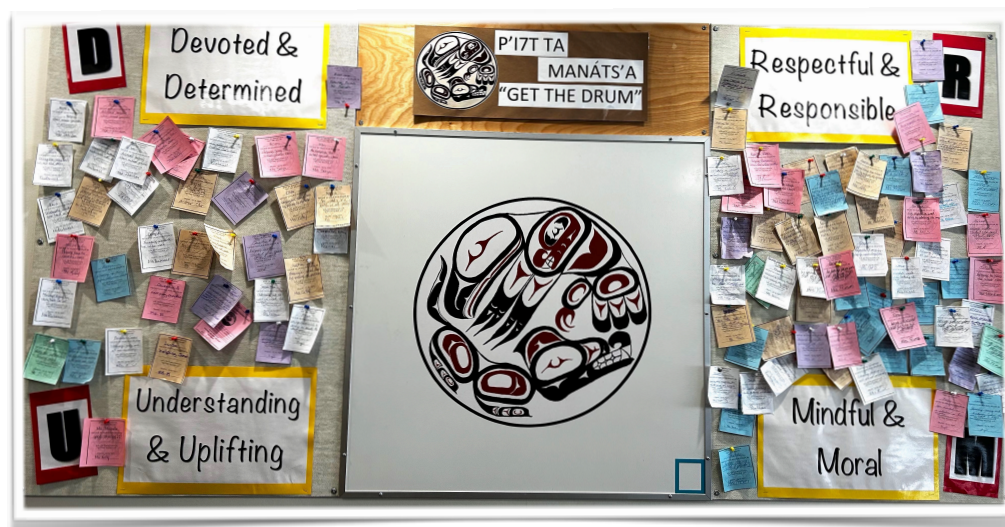
Thinkers: Grade 4 students theorized about how artifacts that originated in one part of Canada were later found far away from their places of origin.

Some examples of student actions that were recognized for DRUM tickets follow (:

Devoted & Determined - Being very engaged and asking great questions about what we were learning, to gain better understanding

Respectful & Responsible (IB Learner Profile: Caring) - Inviting other students to play at recess; Helping a staff member work more comfortably with a student by bringing her a chair; cleaning up litter on the playground (and not littering!!); Catching up on work missed when absent

Understanding & Uplifting (IB Learner Profiles: Knowledgeable, Thinkers, Uplifting...) - Helping a classmate by showing them what to do to be ready for the lesson; “thinking outside the box” to extend her own and others’ thinking

Mindful & Moral - Helping a student by translating so that the student could meaningfully participate and share their ideas (IB learner Profiles: Communicator & Caring); Alerting a staff member when a student looked upset and left the school grounds (IB Learner Profiles: Communicator, Principled, Caring).

The list could go on... Please talk with your children about how they support “Earning Our DRUM” at school, and praise them for their positive contributions. Also, please consider how your child can demonstrate being Devoted & Determined, Respectful & Responsible, Understanding & Uplifting, and Mindful & Moral at home. *We are so appreciative of our students’ positive actions - way to go and let’s go!!*
