## 2. Update Glenda

- School district informed us that there are many students in the area with
  no placement currently. Grade 1 is the largest intake. We may make an
  entire new grade 1 class if enough students arrive. This will involve some
  classroom movements to keep the primary grade levels closer together.
  Enrollment is occurring day by day. A grade 1 teacher will need to also be
  hired to accommodate this change.
- Q: PAC funding per student will this be affected? Jeremy: Ask NV PAC?
- If anyone has any specific questions on what this will bring, ask Glenda directly
- As of July 2023, we will have a new reporting order, you can <u>read about it</u> here, but the changes are:
  - 4 point proficiency scale for reporting currently @ Norgate (beginning, dev, practising and extending) – different names but essentially the same categories
  - This will preclude student/teacher/parent conferences, but will be replaced with 2 "written learning updates" plus a final written "summary of learning" and 2 informal conferences
  - Informal conference could be a phone call, a meeting after school, email etc.
  - National Indigenous Veterans Day and Remembrance Day ceremonies tomorrow. Room for family/parents limited but available
