Bullying Awareness Week is NOT about what others could or should be doing, but rather what WE can do!

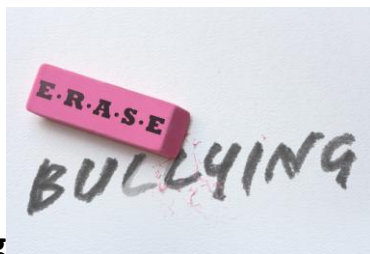
Everyone has the right to be respected and the responsibility to respect others, in person and online!
