Monday Message

Dear Ross Road Families,

This week the newsletter contains a number of important reminders. We appreciate you reading it carefully. We encourage families to maintain communication with the classroom teacher and to remain curious about your children's learning, interactions and experiences at school.

This week at Ross Road the Second Step message classes are discussing is about Identifying Feelings:

We're all learning to identify our own and others' feelings. We can focus our attention on someone's face or body on the situation for clues about how the person is feeling. Sometimes people's voices and the words they say also give us clues. If someone is yelling, it might be that this person is angry. If a person is using a very quiet voice, it might be that this person is scared or worried. This week, listen to people's voices for clues to figure out how they might be feeling!

Health and Safety Reminders

It is important that we remain careful and vigilant in respecting provincial restrictions and protocols that are in place to protect ourselves and others during the COVID-19 pandemic. We continue to review school and classroom health and safety procedures with our students. We ask that parents, caregivers and other adults in our community pay special attention to provincial restrictions and guidelines including physical distancing, gathering restrictions, and the use of masks for adults.

Severe Weather Reminder

We would like to remind parents, guardians, and students about the North Vancouver School District's winter weather procedures and announcements. All schools in the North Vancouver School District will remain OPEN, if at all possible during winter weather, including snowfalls. Any district-wide closure will be decided by 6:30 a.m. and will be announced through the media, placed on the school district website and schools' websites, shared with parents/guardians via School Messenger (email and/or text), and emailed to
