You can report your child's absence *in advance* using any of these three options, which are available to you 24 hours/day, 7 days a week:

MunchaLunch REMINDER

First, office staff and teachers would like to remind families to please send a substantial snack on hot lunch days. Students are frequently reporting they have no snack and are hungry at recess.

The MunchaLunch system sends a reminder to families the day before each hot lunch. It lists the food items that you have ordered for your child. It is helpful if you remind your child what food items they will be receiving. *If you do not receive an email, this means that we do not have an order from you for that week and you will need to send a lunch with your child. While we try to supply children with lunches when they don't have one, we don't always have extra food available. You can log into your "Munch" account at any time to view your paid orders.
