Dear Parents and Guardians,

Returning to a re-instatement of extracurricular athletics in schools is very exciting for students, as well as for our athletic leaders, coaches and school community. To maintain this level of sport while ensuring the health and safety of all students and staff, organizers must carefully consider the guidelines provided by BC School Sports, follow all School District and Ministry of Education Guidelines, and of course, abide by the current orders from BC's Provincial Health Officer related to Covid-19.

A natural part of supporting your children to participate in school sports is to watch them take part in games and sometimes practices. Therefore, the leaders across all Secondary Schools in North Vancouver have met and have recognized the value of parents spectating, while still maintaining the safety of students, staff, and the community.

The following conditions are required for spectating indoor extracurricular athletics in North Vancouver Schools:

- All spectators, visitors, coaches, and student athletes **may only attend when they are healthy and symptom free**. All individuals must complete a regular self ["Health Screening", using the signs and symptoms checklist.](#)
- All spectators and visitors are required to complete the **health check / visitor sign in** prior to entering the building. Upon entry to Seycove, please use the QR code posted at the main entrance to the gym to sign in for contact tracing and acknowledge your completion of your [daily health check.](#)
- **Masks** are required to be worn by spectators and adults at all times inside the facility. Student athletes are to wear masks at all times except when engaged in high intensity play (they may also wear a mask during game play if they choose to).
- **Social and Physical distancing** is practiced (six feet space between participants unless they are family).
- **Facility Capacity Limit** are adhered to (50% of available seating or as posted by the school).

Finally, as a reminder, all other School Districts and schools outside of the North Vancouver School District may have different approaches to visitors and spectators. Therefore, parents should check spectator guidelines prior to making plans for spectating at other locations.

Thank-you for your support in keeping our school community and student-athletes safe, healthy and active.
