

North Vancouver Parent Advisory Council - NVPAC - is the District Parent Advisory Council for the North Vancouver School District. Our members are the PACs from the schools in the North Vancouver School District. We represent the parents of North Van at the District level. NVPAC offers grants to PACs to assist them in providing speakers for parent education, to ensure that volunteers overseeing food sales have the required FoodSafe certification, and to support communication and co-operation between the schools within a Family of Schools.
