Principal's Report	Ms. Pam Craven	 Course verification – email going out to ensure they are handed in Important that these forms come in ASAP for course offerings because we are a small school and want to ensure that the requests for specific classes are correct Blocks – preliminary numbers are in from the course verification forms – beginning the process to allocated to courses based on requests The grade 12's have priority in the grade 12 courses – grade 11's can take it, then the question becomes are we building a schedule for grade 11's or for grade 12's – ensuring that the 12's have the priority classes first – gr 11 could always take it the following year Pre-course for socials – Exploration course 11 – not offered before, part of the new curriculum 	

- From a staffing perspective: gr 11 take the course, funded by course for 10, 11, 12, then more blocks to work with and could increase staffing slightly
- Student perspective: most university look at gr 12 credits, socials 11 may not be relevant
- 1 block of socials 11 teachers will now have input around who is capable of jumping from a grade 10 to a grade 12 course. Teachers can talk to the kids about what next step is for them.
- Parent information night with grade 10 parents next year for programming night – promote socials 11 – important foundation, ensure basics prior to grade 12 – where it is more in depth with specific foci.
- Staff meeting: worked on setting up classes within the portal for students to share their core competencies self-assessment
- 8, 9, 10 Science & 11 English teachers
 - Set up their classes in the online portal, attach assignments and learned how to use the course shell in this learning management system. The rest of the teachers have a scheduled time to rotate through computer lab to complete this work
- Our school survey: students go through lab to completed
- Awards:
 - o Night of recognition: Grade 8-11 students
 - Last Friday of the school year, Gradef 8/9 & 10/11 assembly during the day – subject, service, athletic awards
 - Input received from teachers for names of students
