Teachers Changes/Updates:

EA/Annie will work with students in ASL course — she has a letter of permission to teach due to specialty area. In terms of teaching ASL, the expectation from the deaf community is that it is taught by someone from the community. Postings have gone out broadly outside of BC and Canada.

Grade 8: 31 students Level 1 ASL - full Level 2 ASL – full

Emersion between students who are deaf and students who are hearing has been successful. A presentation by students to the school board was made completely in sign with an interpreter for the board members and was very well received.
