# **DRUGS, ALCOHOL, SMOKING, VAPING & E-CIGS**

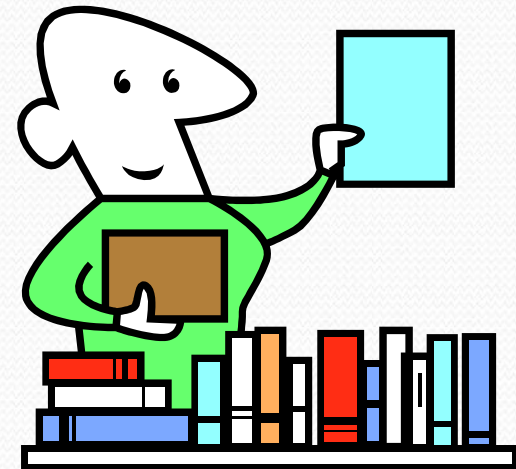
Students are not permitted to smoke, Vape or carry vapes, or be with anyone vaping anywhere within the school or on school grounds.
