JANUARY

Beedie Luminaries (110 x \$15,000 - \$40,000)

For BC students who are resilient, facing financial adversity, who have grit to create positive change in their lives and the lives of others.

Deadline: January 13, 2022

STEAM Horizon Awards (5 x \$25,000)

A \$25,000 student prize for inspiring achievements in science, technology, engineering, arts, and math. 2 of these 5 awards will be given to Indigenous students.

Deadline: January 14, 2022

SPEATBC Scholarships (5 x \$1,000)

5 scholarships (entrance, post-secondary, woman in engineering, new immigrant and international student) for applicants who will attend a university or college in BC in the field of engineering or technology.

Deadline: January 15th, 2022

Schulich Leaders Scholarship (\$80,000 - \$100,000)

For students interested in pursuing a career and post-secondary studies in Science, Tech, Engineering, who have academic excellence, leadership, and perhaps financial need. One nomination per school. **Nomination application deadline: December 6, 2021.**

Cmolik Foundation Scholarships (\$40,000)

YVR Emerging Artist Scholarship Program (\$5000)

Scholarships are awarded to emerging Indigenous artists who create visual art that reflects BC or Yukon First Nations culture and who wish to develop their art practice through education or mentorships.

For service, leadership, commitment, academics (\$5,500) x 55 in the province. One nomination per school. **Nomination Deadline: January 28, 2022 (check MS Teams for application)**

Les Dames d'Escoffie British Columbia (\$300-\$2000)

Scholarship for women with a desire to begin training in culinary, beverage or hospitality fields, and to women already skilled in these fields who seek to refine or further their expertise at an educational institution/course of their choice.

David C Lam/BC TEAL ESL Scholarship (\$3000)

The David C. Lam/BC TEAL ESL recognizes an English language learner graduating from a BC secondary school who has combined academic competence with school and community service, and who wishes to further his/her education at a post-secondary institution in British Columbia. (International students on student visas are not eligible for this award).
