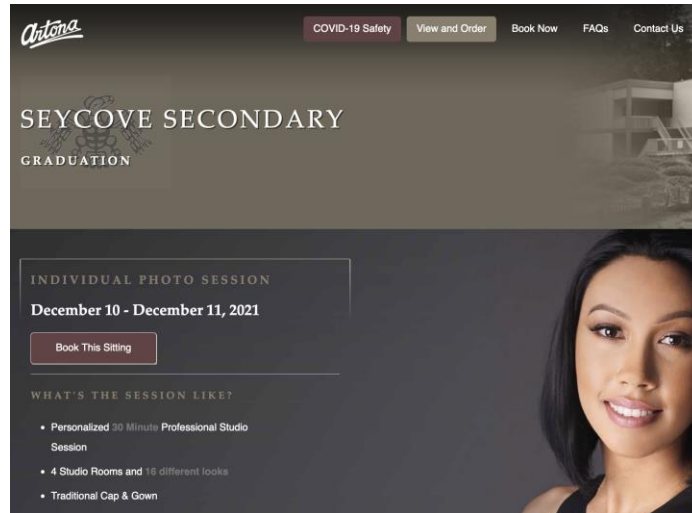

3. **Parent Dedication and Baby Photo for the Yearbook (Please Note this is *OPTIONAL*)**

You have the *option* to have your child's baby photo printed in the yearbook alongside a 100-word (max.) dedication to your child. If you would like to do this, please include the dedication in the same email as the baby photo, and in the subject line write "BABY DEDICATION REQUEST" in capital letters. Deadline is December 15, 2021.

There is a charge of \$20 to offset the additional yearbook pages if you choose to have the baby photo and dedication printed in the yearbook. This fee can **only be paid** via your School Cash Online account [HERE](#).

Grad Fees

Your Graduation Activity Fee is \$45. All fees must be paid online through [School Cash Online](#). Additional optional fees include:

- Winter Semi-Formal – TBD (approx. \$80)
- Graduation Cap & Gown – Included in Grad Activity Fee
- Graduation Valedictory Ceremony– Free
- Graduation Banquet – TBD (approx. \$150-\$170)
- Graduation Banquet Boat Cruise (approx. \$60-\$100)



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Convocation Ceremony Profile	Each grade 12 will submit their profile write-up in their English 12 class. The Grade 12 Valedictory Ceremony Profile is for every grade 12 student participating in the Convocation Ceremony. It is read as they cross the stage at the venue. If students do not hand in a write-up, school administration will write something for them.
Valedictorian	Valedictorian candidates will submit nominations in the Spring (date TBD). To be considered as valedictorian students must: demonstrate positive citizenship, have excellent attendance, and be prepared to present 3 minutes of their speech to a panel of grad sponsors and school administration for consideration for Valedictorian.
Grad Council	Grad Council is sponsored by Ms. Yeo and Ms. Eyton. Grade 12 students on Grad Council were selected by their peers to represent their grad class in June 2021. They meet every Thursday morning to discuss school activities, fundraisers and multiple grad events. Some of Seycove's annual grad events are: dress-up days, grad boat cruise (December), grad snack store, grad gift to school, Renaissance Award, fundraisers and helping shape the grad banquet and convocation. Valedictory Ceremony Rehearsal & Gown Pick-up	<p>The rehearsal for the Grade 12 Valedictory Ceremony will take place in the gym a few days ahead of the Valedictory Ceremony. <u>Attendance is compulsory for all participants!</u> Students will learn and practice the organization protocols for the ceremony.</p> <p>Grad gown order will be collected starting in early January 2022.</p> <p>All students participating in the Valedictory Ceremony will need to order and pick up their grad gowns and wear it to the Ceremony; the gown is their ticket into the event. Grad gown pick-up dates and times will be shared with grads closer to the date. <u>All outstanding school fees must be paid</u> in order to pick up your gown. Check your School Cash Online account to check and pay your school fees.</p>



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Valedictory Ceremony

June 10th, 2022

The Grade 12 Valedictory Ceremony will take place in our Seycove Gym. The date will be June 10th, 2022. Grads will need to be at the venue one hour before the ceremony begins. Grads must arrive wearing their gown as the gown is their ticket into the event. Guests and grads will enter through the Gym doors. The entrance doors will open one hour before the ceremony. Tickets for family members to attend the event will be available in the month prior to the ceremony. Students will be provided a limit of 4 tickets. **NO TICKETS WILL BE AVAILABLE AT THE DOOR.** If you have guests that need special seating please contact Ms. Best.

- Formal Atmosphere: Audience should dress and conduct themselves in a manner appropriate to the formality of the occasion.
- Photography: Photographs of each grad will be taken on stage by Artona. Do not approach the stage or block the aisles to take photographs.

Grad Banquet (June)

June 28th, 2022

The Grade 12 Banquet will take place at the Harbourfront Pinnacle Hotel (downtown venue) on Tuesday, June 28th from 6:00pm-Midnight. Tickets will go on sale online through school cash online from approximately one month prior to the event. The ticket price will be approximately \$150-\$170 per ticket; everyone requires a ticket to attend. Seating must be chosen after tickets are purchased and all grads must have paid before a whole table can be reserved. It is best to pick seats as soon as tickets are purchased and to organize seating with friends and family. All grads must be present to sign up for their table grouping (ie. you can't sign up friends at your table). It is tradition for Seycove's grads to meet at Panorama Park in Deep Cove for a group photo and then board Harbour Cruiseline to get downtown to the Pinnacle together. This boat cruise is optional and typically costs \$60-\$100 depending on how many grads participate. **NO TICKETS WILL BE SOLD AT THE DOOR.** The Grad Banquet is a dry event and security guards are onsite to ensure all graduates are in compliance. There are no in and out privileges given. It is also a tradition for grade 12 parents to organize a river rafting trip for grads to participate in on the night of the banquet (departing from the hotel at approximately 11:30pm).
