Former National and Professional basketball players, and now North Vancouver Basketball Academy coaches, Ransford Brempong and Levon Kendall, along with current head coach of Women's Basketball at Capilano University, Chris Weimer, lead students from North Vancouver Schools through a fast paced, high energy, developmental and high performance basketball curriculum. The NVBA believes the strength of "The Academy" lies in our coaches and their ability to motivate and push the student-athletes to be human beings of integrity and high character, while reaching their highest potential as Basketball Players.

The program consists of the Basketball Academy curriculum as set out by Basketball BC and the Physical and Health Education curriculum established by the B.C Ministry of Education. Students earn their grade level P.H.E. credit upon successful completion of the program. The Academy will be held in either Block 4 or 8 of the secondary school timetable, depending on the cohort and location. Participation in the Basketball Academy will not affect a student's eligibility to play for their home school's basketball team.
