




Dear Neighbour:

Starting October 17, construction will begin on the Lynn Valley Road Widening, Safety Improvements and Bike Lanes Project between Mollie Nye Way and Morgan Road.

This project involves temporarily removing the centre median, and paving a temporary lane to help with traffic management during construction. The road will then be widened from Mollie Nye Way to Morgan Road to create room for separated cycling lanes. The landscaped median will be replaced once the project is complete.

During construction, pedestrian access will be limited on the south side of Lynn Valley Road and bus stops will be temporarily relocated. Please watch project signage for further details.

Traffic management plans are in place and traffic control personnel will be on site during construction to ensure minimal impacts to our residents, however a temporary increase in noise and traffic congestion during construction are to be expected. *Please follow all signage and flag person directions when travelling in the area.*
