

The Job of Parent/Guardian ...


- Keep involved in their journey!

EXIT vs ENTRANCE Looking ahead ...

High School Graduation

- 80 credits (minimum) over Grades 10-12
- Second Language is not required to graduate
- Any Math 11 will fulfill graduation requirements

Post-Secondary Entrance

- High School Graduation with institution-specific entrance requirements
- Second Language 11 required to enter UBC and SFU
- Most universities require the Foundations / Pre-Calculus Math pathway to at least the grade 11 level


