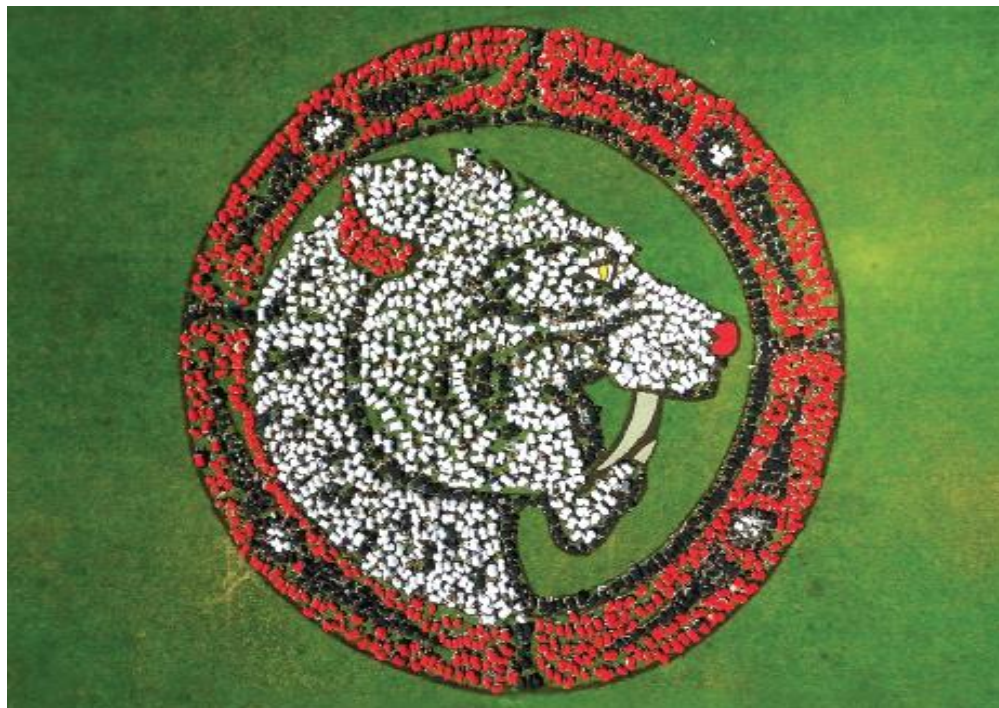

- Check in regularly, with student **AND** school 😊



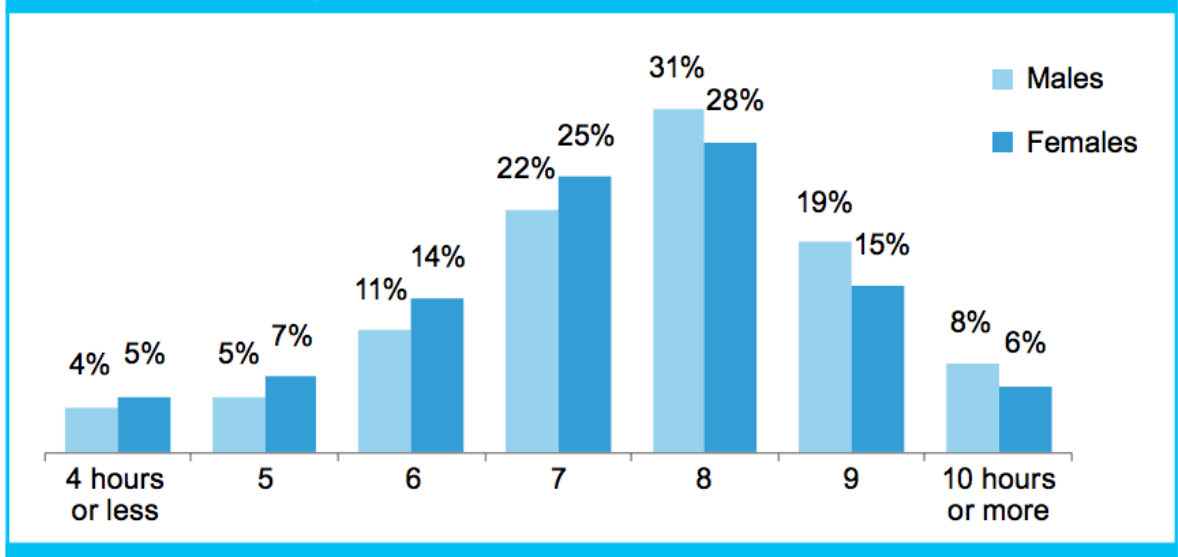
Sleep ...



- 8.5 to 9.25 hours per night is recommended
- #1 distraction and interference with sleep is electronic devices

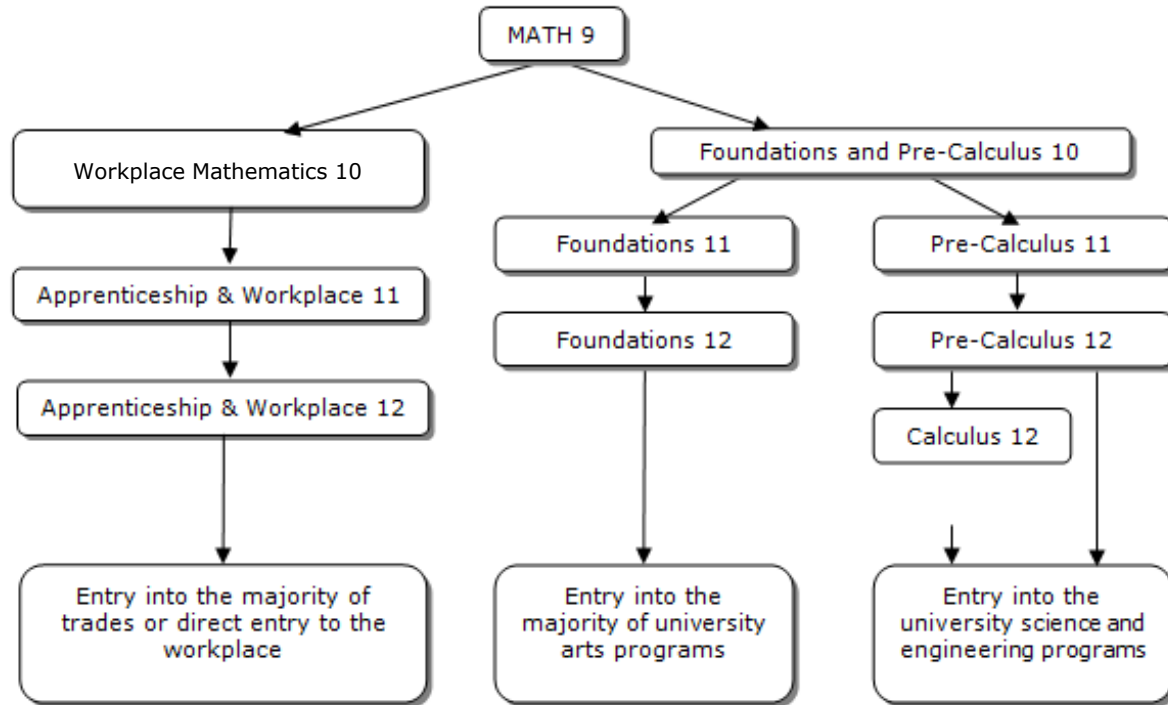

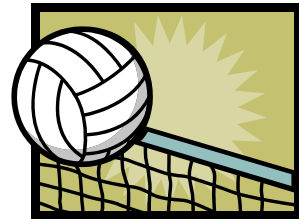
- Minimum of 15 hours per week of elite level sports

- Completed Application
- Approval by school Principal
- Deadline for application May 2018
