
Grade 7/8 Transition

Supporting Students' Academic and Social Transition

The purpose of Grade 7/8 transition is to provide Grade 7 students with a variety of experiences to connect them to their secondary school before they begin Grade 8. This connection focuses on the development of plans to support the course selection process, and determine any additional supports that may be required for individual students. Additional supports may address both academic and social / emotional needs. More importantly, transition supports every elementary student to feel a sense of welcome, belonging, and excitement about entering secondary school.

The North Vancouver School District's Grade 7/8 Transition Parent Information document provides an overview of events and procedures that support students and their families during the Transition process.

The Transition process begins in the fall of Grade 7 and continues into the fall of Grade 8. Many processes and activities occur during this transition time frame. Activities may include visits to secondary schools, social events, tours, Grade 7 partnerships with older students, and Grade 7



sporting events hosted at the secondary school.




SLEEP ...
