Full Day Kindergarten is provided as a separate or blended K/1 class in all elementary schools in the North Vancouver School District.

Kindergarten

- creates a secure transition from learning at home to learning at school
- nurtures children's naturally inquisitive, imaginative and active learning styles
- offers children play-based opportunities to explore and learn in a safe, secure environment

Our Kindergarten programs follow the B.C. curriculum, providing our youngest learners with a balance of child-initiated play and focused experiential learning, in both indoor and outdoor environments. Play-based learning supports and enhances every aspect of children's development - social, emotional, physical, aesthetic, artistic and academic.



Kindergarten Registration

Kindergarten registration for the 2016-2017 school year begins at the Education Services Centre on November 2, 2015. The deadline for priority placement is December 18, 2015.

Children who turn 5 by December 31, 2016 are eligible to be registered for Kindergarten in September 2016.
