Created by the World Wildlife Fund (WWF) in 2010, the goal of Sweater Day is to encourage Canadians to turn down the heat by two degrees, while bundling up in their favourite sweater. If all organizations and residents in Canada were to participate, it would reduce greenhouse gas emissions by about 4 megatons – equivalent to taking nearly 700,000 cars off the road or shutting down a 600 megawatt coal-fired power station.
