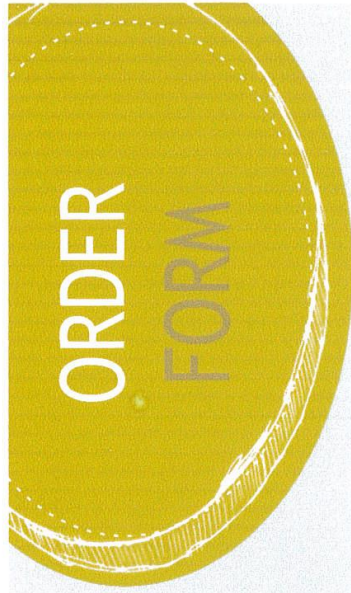
As a means of keeping all information we have on file for your child current, please contact the office if your address and or home/cell/work phone numbers have recently changed.
