For 2020: Students in Grades 4, 7, 10 and 12 complete the survey;  
Parents/Guardians of Grade 4, 7, 10 and 12 Students complete the survey; and all Staff associated with a School complete the survey. Schools may survey other grade levels after finishing the grades above.

### **To complete the survey:**

1. Go to [www.bced.gov.bc.ca/sat\\_survey/access.htm](http://www.bced.gov.bc.ca/sat_survey/access.htm)
2. Under the section *Direct Access – no logon number required* select:
  - District: 44 North Vancouver
  - School: Westview Elementary
  - Language: the language of your choice
3. Complete the survey by clicking on the appropriate circle to answer each question. Move to the next set of questions by clicking on the right arrow in the bottom right corner of the screen. Click on the left arrow to navigate backwards.
4. When you are finished the survey, you will get a message “Thank you for sharing your views”.
5. Once complete, your school will have the results immediately.
